



## CALL FOR POSTERS

We invite poster proposals for presentation at the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Collaborative Perspectives on Addiction (CPA2021) Conference! CPA2021 represents a tremendous opportunity to present your work, network with other scholars with shared interests, and learn about the latest in addiction psychology research! Particularly, we encourage addiction psychology research focusing on diversity issues and/or underrepresented minority populations, and welcome poster submissions from scholars of diverse backgrounds.

The theme for CPA2021 continues the theme from CPA2020: *Substance Use and Addictive Behaviors across the Lifespan*. Amid the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) global pandemic, CPA2021 **Poster Sessions** will be held virtually, in conjunction with the regular symposium\* and social network programming during March 18-20, 2021.

\*Accepted symposia from CPA2020 have been given the opportunity to present during CPA2021. There will not be a separate call for new oral presentation submissions.

### SUBMISSION

Each poster proposal should be submitted via a standard form, where you will include a 225-word abstract. The abstract should summarize the significance of the research questions, study design and sample characteristics (if appropriate), analytic strategies, key findings, and conclusion.

Each scholar may submit ONE (1) poster proposal as a first author. In the event that multiple poster proposals are received from the same first author, the first submission will be reviewed. Each scholar may be listed as a co-author on multiple poster proposals.

### REVIEW

Four scoring criteria\*\* will be used to evaluate each poster proposal:

- **Overall Quality/Importance:** Justify that the study addresses significant research questions
- **Innovation/Originality:** Indicate that the study yields novel knowledge in addiction psychology
- **Approach/Methodology:** Summarize rigorous and sound research methods
- **Diversity Considerations:** Discuss relevance to underrepresented minority groups, issues related to generalizability, and/or implications for research with diverse populations

\*\*Fit with conference theme is NOT a criterion for the peer review process or a requirement for acceptance. Each submission will be reviewed by a minimum of 2 doctoral-level peer reviewers.
