Individuals with comorbid psychopathology suffer disproportionately from substance use disorders and related risks, such as violence and HIV. Likewise, addiction introduces myriad physical and mental health problems, particularly with respect to fetal development, long-term chronic illnesses, and psychopathology.

With that in mind, symposia for CPA 2017 may include (but are not limited to):

- New approaches to addiction science—from basic laboratory research to epidemiology and policy—that may help to better understand the etiology and nature of substance-related risk
- New approaches for assessing substance use and comorbid symptoms that might shed light on these risks
- Novel treatments or existing treatments that have been carefully adapted to address co-occurring symptoms, or to enhance physical health/wellness (e.g., exercise or mindfulness based interventions) or social functioning.
- New approaches to adopting, disseminating, and enhancing evidence-based practices to reach larger segments of the population and to reduce comorbidity

We intend for the Collaborative Perspectives on Addiction meeting to provide a forum for the presentation of novel findings and new ideas for collaboration from research-to-practice-to-policy.
